



## Skoklosters slott

### Skokloster Castle short info

Skokloster castle was once the home of renowned field marshal Carl Gustav Wrangel of the 30-years war fame.

It is one of the world's best preserved baroque palaces, with intact interiors from three centuries and vast collections of weapons, art and more. Its most sought-after possession is the painting Vertumnus by the 16th century Italian artist Giuseppe Arcimboldo.

Skokloster castle is open all year round to pre-booked tours, and our knowledgeable guides, fluent in several languages, will give you and your visitors an unforgettable experience as they travel together in time back to the 17th century. The tour will take about an hour.

#### **Prices for 2026:**

A pre-booked private tour of the castle has a starting fee of 1 200 SEK for a group of up to 15 participants. To this is added the entrance fee of 140 SEK per person. On weekends, bank holidays, and evenings after 17:00 local time the fee will be 2 200 SEK, entrance fee the same as mentioned above. It is of course possible to have several guided tours at the same time if there is a large group of visitors.

#### **Opening hours 2026:**

The castle is open to the public every day from the 1st of June to the 31st of August, and every weekend during May and September. We are also open during Easter, All Saints' holiday, and have a beloved Christmas market in early December (see our homepage Home - Skoklosters slott for the exact dates).

On these occasions it is possible to visit the castle without making an advance booking. The opening hours are 11:00-17:00 during high season and 11:00-16:00 all other dates. As stated before: See our homepage for the exact dates. The price of admittance is 140 SEK per adult, or 190 SEK for a ticket with included guided tour. Children up to 19 years of age have free entrance and free guided tours if accompanied by an adult with a valid ticket. All audio guides are free of charge.

#### **More:**

Skokloster castle also has a well-stocked museum gift shop and a popular café. In the immediate surroundings are the medieval abbey church and the beautiful castle park

and grounds overlooking the lake Mälaren. The car park is situated 300 metres from the castle entrance.

The distance by car from Stockholm is slightly more than an hour and slightly less from Uppsala. Arlanda airport is 45 minutes away. You can also reach us by boat.
